

Pricing Term Sheet

Evergy Kansas Central, Inc.
First Mortgage Bonds, 5.600% Series due 2034 (the “bonds”)

This pricing term sheet relates to an offering of the bonds by Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. (the “Issuer”) and should be read together with the preliminary prospectus supplement, dated September 10, 2026, relating to such offering (the “Preliminary Prospectus Supplement”), including the accompanying base prospectus, dated August 16, 2024, and the documents incorporated by reference therein. Make-Whole Call:	Prior to November 15, 2033 (the date that is two months prior to the maturity date of the bonds (the “Par Call Date”)), the Issuer may redeem the bonds at its option, in whole or in part, at any time and from time to time, at a redemption price (expressed as a percentage of principal amount and rounded to three decimal places) equal to the greater of: (i)(a) the sum of the present values of the remaining scheduled payments of principal and interest on the bonds discounted to the redemption date (assuming the bonds matured on the Par Call Date) on a semi-annual basis (assuming a 360-day year consisting of twelve 30-day months) at the Treasury Rate plus 15 basis points less (b) interest accrued to the redemption date; and (ii) 100% of the principal amount of the bonds to be redeemed, plus, in either case, accrued and unpaid interest thereon to, but excluding, the redemption date

Par Call:	On or after the Par Call Date, the Issuer may redeem the bonds at its option, in whole or in part, at any time and from time to time, at a redemption price equal to 100% of the principal amount of the bonds to be redeemed, plus accrued and unpaid interest thereon to, but excluding, the redemption date
Tax Credit Event Call:	Upon the occurrence of a Tax Credit Event, the Issuer may redeem the bonds, in whole but not in part, at 101% of the principal amount of the bonds to be redeemed plus accrued and unpaid interest thereon to, but excluding, the redemption date (provided that the notice of such redemption may be issued no later than March 16, 2027)

* It is expected that delivery of the bonds will be made against payment therefor on or about September 16, 2026, which will be the fourth business day (T+4) following the date hereof. Under Rule 15c6-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, trades in the secondary market generally are required to settle in one business day, unless the parties to a trade expressly agree otherwise. Accordingly, purchasers who wish to trade the bonds on any date prior to the first business day before delivery of the bonds will be required, by virtue of the fact that the bonds initially will settle in T+4, to specify alternative settlement arrangements to prevent a failed settlement and should consult their own advisors.
